
Key themes

- 1. Historic dock infrastructure is beautiful, but **designed to** keep the city outside its walls
- 2. Getting to the waterfront from the rest of the city is hard, with lots of **barriers and gaps** in the urban fabric
- 3. Once you're on the waterfront, moving **along north-south is** also difficult, with lots of gates, fences, and paving materials
- 4. The waterfront's natural climate is made worse with big, barren spaces that amplify wind and cold
- 5. The waterfront **lacks space for locals to live their lives**, with a focus on major attractions and excessive parking


Operational locks that connect to the Leeds canal, with small footpaths and minimal landscaping.

Meanwhile, the lorry parking lot south of the Locks can host a new MerseyRail station in the future.








Baltic Beach

Floating park that brings the success of the Baltic to the Waterfront






The Baltic Triangle is one of Liverpool's greatest new assets. Yet, this neighborhood is completely cut off from the waterfront. We propose giving the Baltic a piece of the water in the form of a floating dockside park, allowing the dynamism and creativity of this thriving neighborhood to influence and benefit the waterfront.



A "String of Pearls" along the water's edge






The Marina area currently presents itself as an interruption of the waterfront's continuity, with a meandering edge that is often hard to follow. The alternate route, through the residential area, feels like a back-of-house world not meant for pedestrians.

We propose to connect the waterfront back to itself via a "string of pearls" along the Marina edge, with new bridge links and a green park redevelopment that serves Marina residents and offers a green respite along this somewhat forbidding portion of the water.



Live, work, and connect to the waterfront






Brunswick Business Park has a number of beautiful historic warehouses currently hosting an array of businesses. The Business Park is not well connected to Brunswick Station, and it is surrounded by fencing, making it a barrier on the Waterfront.

We propose adding significant residential development between the historic warehouses, along with a decked elevated park covering the parking lots. Additional development to the north and stronger connections would transform this area into a new hub of creative businesses and residential.

Sandwiched between the business park and the new Festival Gardens site is a long, narrow strip of Trans-Pennine Trail that is inset from the rest of the Mersey bulkhead wall slightly. Brunswick Beach is a public space that expands the existing trail into a terraced park, from the coach parking on the eastern side of the road to the water's edge. A lower-level deck path is flooded at high tide, allowing people to make contact with the river when the tide is going out.





Otter's Pool

Historic estuarine marsh






Otterspool, at the very end of the Liverpool waterfront, contains a number of recreational facilities and an under-used wooded area. The wide grassy berms fronting the river are covering a raised landfill. Historically, there was a natural break in the river leading into an estuarine pool called Otter's Pool.

We propose restoring Otter's Pool and introducing it as an enhanced habitat and natural area for recreation and nature. We are exploring two proposals that would allow us to do this, creating a dynamic tidal landscape that encourages contact with the river in a safe and contained way, further inland.
